Guest Speaker Alexa Roberts with Historical Society

Alexa spends her time fighting for the preservation of old historic buildings in Roseville (Belvedere) Anyone can buy a historic building in Roseville as there are no preservation ordinances within the city. The Belvedere preservation alliance is her new nonprofit. Alexa would like people to sign her petition to have a preservation ordinance for the city put into place.

Guest Speaker Sara Stansler with Flock Safety/License plate reader cameras

Cost of each camera is \$2,500 and that locks you into a 2 year contract. Flock recommends 2 cameras per install to achieve better views. Statistics from Two different counties showed a significant reduction in crime rates from having the cameras. Installing them at the entrances of Your neighborhood means the NA is the sole owner of the camera system, as well as having the ability to grant RPD access to your system.

Roseville Police Update

James Haggerty with RPD was in attendance and reiterated the benefits of having the flock cameras. Kevin asked Officer Haggerty to work with Ed Kris on what time would be more efficient for them to provide update at our meeting.
